Bill Demas' Westmoreland Railroad ([photo below](#)). HO scale layout, set during the 1950s era is built on two peninsulas connected by wall shelves and approximately 14' by 15' in size. He uses Digitrax DDC as his control system with Code 100 Atlas flex track and Atlas Custom Line and Peco turnouts.

There is a significant amount of operational capacity in a small space with around 20 switching locations on the layout. In addition, Bill's layout also pays tribute to late Potomac Division members Marshall Abrams and Tom Brodrick, both of whom were part of his original operating group.
