
4. Nigel Phillips' Two Trestles



These are the On30 narrow gauge trestles I built last year for an On30 layout. Dimensional lumber and white glue, bent angle 1:12. I based the design on plans from "A Treatise on Wooden Trestle Bridges" by Wolcott Cronk Foster, John Wiley & Sons, 1897. The long one is slightly curved and adjusted for elevation. I learned a lot about the multitude of parts and their dimensions. Most plans in model railroading publications are way too simple (and wrong).
