

10. Bob Rodriguez's Sheppardsfield, Pennsylvania



Sheppardsfield is a small town situated 12 miles west of Karthaus, Pennsylvania on Bob Rodriguez's free-lance Nickel City Line Railroad. The town is built along three curved tracks in the Alleghany Mountains and is a great spot for rail fans to see lots of train action in both directions. Numerous freight, coal, and passenger trains frequent Sheppardsfield daily. Several small industries are served off the main line. The town was inspired by the real town of Saluda, North Carolina which sits at the top of the famous Saluda Grade and is also built along a curved rail line which was part of Norfolk Southern but has now been abandoned. **Bob Rodriguez**
