

# 1. John Paganoni's Night Scene



This structure represents the Shelton Loom Company in my hometown of Montville, Connecticut. It was located on the Palmertown Branch of the Central Vermont Railway. The lighting is by LED lamps. The ones on the ends of the building are goose necks with shades and the interior ones are straight pole type lamps hanging from the ceiling. The structure was made from two modified/detailed Walther's "American Millwork Co." kits. The smokestack is also a Walthers kit. I understand this mill is currently being converted to residential and office spaces. I do hope they retain the smokestack as it is the only one left in Montville and should be listed as an historical structure. Sadly the entire Palmertown Branch was removed due to a flood washout of a trestle in the 1980's. *John Paganoni, MMR*
