

3. Lee Stoermer's Lineboro Depot



This is the Western Maryland Railroad's Lineboro, Maryland depot. It was scratchbuilt using artist carving foam. A stencil was made based on photos of each side of the building, traced, then individually carved. It has an interior on the main floor and operational freight doors that slide open. The siding is commercially available material, roofing is printed shingles from home computer based on an early rendition of the structure. Other details are scratch or commercially available. Signs are from home printer. The structure still stands today, slightly altered and renovated, in use by the adjoining feed mill for storage. *Lee Stoermer*
