

3. Alex Belida's Woodsboro Station



This is a scratchbuilt HO model of a combined passenger and freight station that once served Woodsboro, Maryland. It became part of a diorama I made for my Master Builder-Prototype Models that also included an old mill, a hardware store and a couple of houses. In the early 1900s, the station, built in 1883, sent off milk can-like containers of locally-raised goldfish all around the United States. These are visible in the photos. The station was served by the Frederick and Pennsylvania line that ran down to Frederick from York. It eventually became part of the Pennsylvania Railroad.
