ACROSS

1. This yard, located near Virginia Beach, Virginia, is part of the Buckingham Branch Railroad.
3. This is the largest railroad classification yard in the world.
7. Operated by Norfolk Southern and also known as the Linwood Yard this yard is near Salisbury, N.C.
10. A former RF&P now CSX yard located northwest of Richmond, Va.
12. This Norfolk Southern yard is located in East Pennsboro Township, Pennsylvania.
14. The Southern, Pennsylvania Railroad, Baltimore & Ohio, Chesapeake & Ohio, Atlantic Coast Line, Seaboard Atlantic Line, open this yard on October 15, 1906 and it was decommissioned on by RF&P in 1989.
15. This yard is operated by the CSX Peninsula Division in Richmond, Va.
16. This yard is in South Norfolk, Va. and the home of the Norfolk and Portsmouth Belt Line's offices.

DOWN

1. Home of Norfolk Southern's Pier 6 the largest and fastest transloading facility for coal in the Northern Hemisphere.
2. A freight rail yard in Newark, N.J. that was built by the Lehigh Valley Railroad in 1903.
4. This recently renovated yard located in Swatara Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, (east of Harrisburg) is operated by Norfolk Southern.
5. This yard is operated by Norfolk Southern, and was originally built in 1888 by the Norfolk & Western as the divisional halfway point between Norfolk, Va. and Roanoke, Va.
6. This yard, located in Reading, Pa., is operated by Norfolk Southern.
8. Originally built by the Baltimore & Ohio in the 1850's and was known as the "west end" connects the Cumberland, Keystone, and Mountain Divisions of the CSX, has an AMTRAK depot near it and is in the mountains of Maryland.
9. This intermodal yard, operated by Norfolk Southern, is one of the three railroad facilities in the Harrisburg, Pa. area.
11. This yard, in West Virginia, was on the former Baltimore & Ohio and adjoins the Willard Hotel.
13. This yard, located in Chesapeake, Va. is a part of Norfolk Southern.
